
#### **PROGRAM OBJECTIVES**

THIS PROJECT RESPONDS TO THE GLOBAL WATER FUTURES MANDATE AND ADDRESSES SOME OF THE GOALS OUTLINED IN UNDRIP, WHILE OUR COMMUNITY PARTNERS, **THE** HAUDENOSAUNEE OF SIX NATIONS AND LUBICON LAKE NATION, CONTRIBUTE TO OUR KNOWLEDGE OF WATER FUTURES.

- TO IDENTIFY POSSIBLE WAYS TO PREVENT CONTAMINATION OF DRINKING WATER, PROTECT SOURCE WATER AND TREAT DRINKING WATER
- TO IDENTIFY THE HUMAN HEALTH IMPACTS FROM WATER-QUALITY CONTAMINANTS
- TO DETERMINE HOW CANADA WILL ADDRESS WATER RESOURCE PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT CHALLENGES THAT IMPACT INDIGENOUS PEOPLES ACROSS CANADA.
- TO INCLUDE INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE AND AUTHORITIES IN WATER RESOURCE PLANNING, SCIENCE AND GOVERNANCE MODELS FOR WATERSHED MANAGEMENT









### Indigenous Knowledge and Community Team Lead: Dr. Dawn Martin-Hill Community

- The foundations of Indigenous Knowledge underscores creations interconnection and inter-dependence of all life forms.
- Building on the CIHR-IAPH funded Ohero:kon, "Under the Husk" youth program, we will have bilateral training and education of TEK and WS.
- Partnering with the Indigenous Elders and Youth Council, the youth will provide cultural training for researchers and project partners.
- The primary concerns for the two communities are:
  - I. The quality of their drinking water
  - II. The ecological integrity of their source
  - III. Governance of these waters.



#### **ECOSYSTEM HEALTH**

- A COUPLED HYDROLOGICAL MODEL WILL BE DEPLOYED TO EXPLORE THE BIOPHYSICAL AND HYDROLOGICAL PROCESSES AND FEEDBACKS FOR HYDROLOGIC MODELING.
- THE AIM IS TO INVESTIGATE THE IMPACTS OF CLIMATE CHANGE ON HYDROLOGIC PROCESSES, AND EXPLORING THE AFFECTS ON THE WATER AND ECOSYSTEMS OF THESE COMMUNITIES.





#### ECOSYSTEM HEALTH ASSESSMENT TEAM LEAD: DR. PATRICIA CHOW-FRASER

- WATER HAS SPECIAL SPIRITUAL AND CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE TO INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES: THE HEALTH OF THE ECOSYSTEMS AND THAT OF THE PEOPLE ARE INHERENTLY ENTWINED.
  - ECOSYSTEM HEALTH WILL BE QUANTIFIED THROUGH WATER-QUALITY TESTS AND BIOLOGICAL INDICATORS.
  - DETAINING THESE DATA IS NECESSARY TO MAKE INFORMED DECISIONS ON ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, REHABILITATION, AND PROTECTION.



## COMMUNITY HEALTH ASSESSMENT TEAM LEAD: DR. M. CONSTANTINE SAMAAN

- WATER QUALITY IN INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES HAS BEEN IMPACTED BY MULTIPLE FACTORS, AND MONITORING ITS EFFECT ON HEALTH IS CRUCIAL.
  - ENDOCRINE DISRUPTING CHEMICALS (EDCS) ARE COMPOUNDS THAT CAN LEAD TO DELETERIOUS EFFECTS ON HEALTH.
  - THEY MAY HAVE MANY USES THAT CAN CONTAMINATE THE WATER AND CONCENTRATE IN THE FOOD CHAIN.



- The objective is to measure the impact of EDCs in water on the risk of diabetes, hormonal health, gastrointestinal health and cancer.
- We will co-create and use tools that, along with biological samples, will be deployed to determine how EDCs impact the health status and metabolic outcomes of the two communities.

## CO-CREATION PROJECT-HEALTH COMPONENT

- THE OVERARCHING GOAL OF THIS COMPONENT IS TO ASSESS THE EFFECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONTAMINANTS ON HEALTH OUTCOMES
- WE ARE FOCUSED ON MEASURING ENDOCRINE DISRUPTING CHEMICALS
   & PERSISTENT ORGANIC POLLUTANTS
- SURVEYS AND BIOLOGICAL SAMPLE ANALYSES WILL DETERMINE THE EFFECT OF CONTAMINANTS ON THE RISK OF DIABETES, CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASES, AND CANCER
