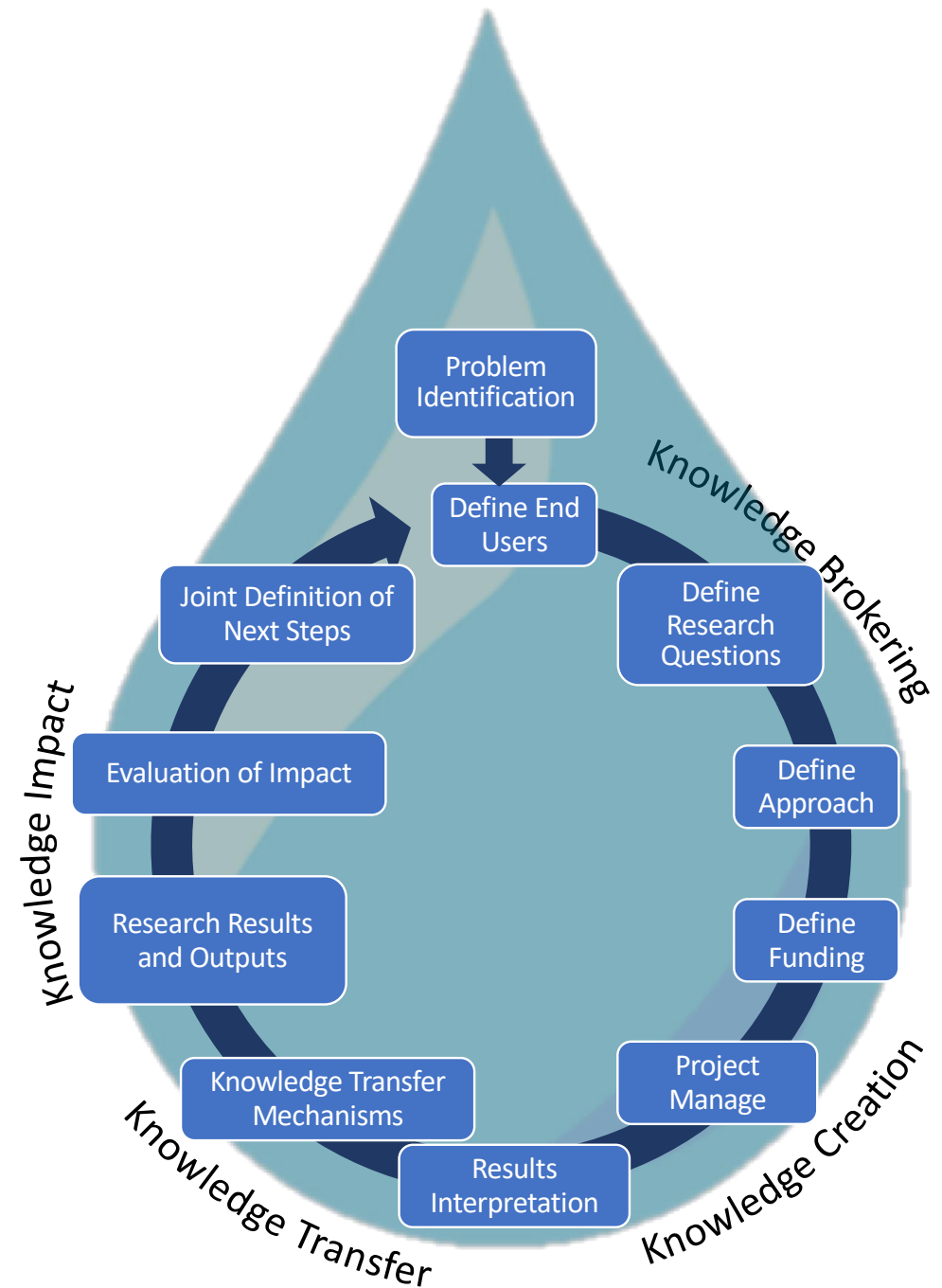

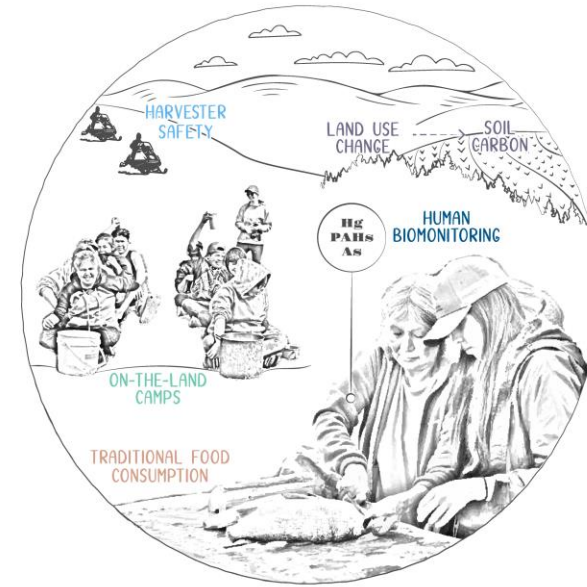
GWF KM Concept Model


